These factors may affect how you should use this medication. Permethrin will disappear as it is absorbed into the skin, and it is not necessary to coat the skin in a visible layer. Many things can affect the dose of a medication that a person needs, such as body weight, other medical conditions and other medications. Symptoms of scabies infestation include itching, redness, and swelling. This does not mean you need to repeat the treatment. Most people do not need a second application. It is important that this medication be used exactly as recommended by your doctor or pharmacist. Applied all over the body, even the face (beware it says not to apply to the face, but I did, was fine for me -- apply at your own discretion). Differing approaches to coverage for OTC products like permethrin existed between provinces. Permethrin 5% was not eligible for coverage by all provinces (eg, British Columbia, Manitoba, Nova Scotia) and the extent of coverage varied.
