Although benzodiazepines are very effective in treating the symptoms of anxiety, they can't be used for long periods of time because they can become addictive if used for longer than four weeks. They may be able to adjust your dose or prescribe an alternative medication. They'll ask you about your previous treatment and how effective you found it. It helps to counter the sense of "tunnel vision" that may develop during anxiety. This type of medicine increases the amount of serotonin and noradrenaline in your brain. Benzodiazepines also start to lose their effectiveness after this time. You should avoid these activities during treatment.
