Voltaren Gel can increase your risk of fatal heart attack or stroke, especially if you use it long term or take high doses, or if you have heart disease. Interactions with medicines, food and alcohol Ibuprofen can react unpredictably with certain other medicines. Avoid getting this medicine near your eyes, nose, or mouth. Common side effects of ibuprofen include: Skip the missed dose if it is almost time for your next scheduled dose. Use Voltaren Gel exactly as prescribed by your doctor. Ask your doctor before using Voltaren Gel if you take an antidepressant such as citalopram, escitalopram, fluoxetine Prozac , fluvoxamine, paroxetine, sertraline Zoloft , trazodone, or vilazodone.
