Use back-up birth control for at least 7 days following the missed pills. An "AB" rating means that the FDA has determined that a generic medication is equivalent to a brand-name medication. If you miss three active pills in a row in Week 1, 2, or 3, throw out the rest of the pack and start a new pack on the same day if you are a Day 1 starter. If you miss one active pill, take two pills on the day you remember. This medicine may also slow breast milk production. This is important for insurance purposes it is less likely to be covered, compared to the generics, and for cost purposes it is usually more expensive than the generics. If you need major surgery with long-term bed rest, you may need to stop using this medicine for a short time. If you are a Sunday starter, keep taking a pill every day until Sunday. Desogen packs contain seven "reminder" pills to keep you on your regular cycle. There are several generic versions of Desogen available. This medicine also causes changes in your cervical mucus and uterine lining, making it harder for sperm to reach the uterus and harder for a fertilized egg to attach to the uterus. This is not a complete list of side effects and others may occur. Some drugs can make birth control pills less effective, which may result in pregnancy. You may need to use back-up birth control, such as condoms or a spermicide, when you first start using Desogen. You may get pregnant if you do not take one pill daily.
