Common examples of prescription opioids include Oxycontin (oxycodone), Vicodin (hydrocodone), morphine, and. Prescription opioids usually come in pill form and are given to treat severe pain for example, pain from dental surgery, serious sports injuries, or cancer. Opioids are also in labs from natural opioids. hydromorphone, hydrocodone, and oxycodone (the prescription drug OxyContin), heroin (which is made from morphine). People who abuse opioids may seek to intensify their experience by taking the drug in ways other than those prescribed. For example, extended-release oxycodone is designed to release slowly and steadily into the bloodstream after being taken orally in a pill; this minimizes the euphoric effects.
