It was approved by the American Academy of Pediatrics for use in breastfeeding mothers (this list is no longer maintained), and has been given Lactation Risk Category L1. Jan 26, - The cases prompted Health Canada to issue an alert about domperidone in March, Some breastfeeding advocates played down the warning, saying the adverse cases weren't really relevant to young healthy nursing mothers. And doctors continued to prescribe the drug on a fairly regular basis. 10 mg of Domperidone (Motilium) three or four times a day is a good starting dose. Mothers who have low milk supply for reasons such as a difficult start with breastfeeding, low prolactin production or who wish to build up a milk supply to nurse an adopted baby, should start at the maximum dose of 20 mg four times a day.
