The active ingredient in Claritin is loratadin, in Allegra it's fexofenadine, and in Zyrtec it's cetirizine. Zyrtec acts the fastest usually within one hour but is also the most likely to make you drowsy, so avoid driving, alcohol, and sedatives as you figure out how you react. Most importantly, talk to your pharmacist and a board-certified allergist. Claritin-D, Allegra-D, and Zyrtec-D all contain a decongestant called pseudoephedrine, the same active ingredient that powers Sudafed. What's the difference between Allegra, Claritin, and Zyrtec?
