Call your doctor for medical advice about side effects. In that case, Clomid is used to augment natural ovulation and can increase the odds of pregnancy in the first few cycles compared to giving no treatment. It causes the pituitary gland to release hormones needed to stimulate ovulation the release of an egg from the ovary. Your doctor will perform medical tests to make sure you do not have conditions that would prevent you from safely using Clomid. Clomid does not have to be taken with food. Clomid is taken for five days at the beginning of the menstrual cycle days three through seven, or days five through nine. The usual dosage ranges from 50 to milligrams. Use of an ovulation predictor kit, blood testing, and/or ultrasound are not required for women using clomiphene, and testing does not improve. Clomiphene citrate is capable of interacting with estrogen-receptor-containing tissues, including the hypothalamus, pituitary, ovary, endometrium, vagina, and cervix.
