Most conditions improve within 4 to 8 weeks and so the medication may be stopped at that time. The suspension form should be shaken well before each use. Famotidine suffers from poor bioavailability (50%), as it is poorly soluble in the low pH of the stomach. When used in combination with antacids, it promotes local delivery of these drugs to the receptor of the parietal cell wall.
