When treating schizophrenia, a total daily dosage of 1015 mg is usually effective. Olanzapine has the potential to produce a serious side effect called tardive dyskinesia. When used to treat schizophrenia, 510 mg is the typical starting dosage. An occasionally reported side effect of olanzapine is neuroleptic malignant syndrome. Any drug that causes drowsiness may lead to decreased mental alertness and impaired motor skills when taken with olanzapine. Other side effects that are possible include rash, body aches and pains, elevated liver enzymes, vision abnormalities, chest pain, or rapid heartbeats. Carbamazepine Tegretol, a drug commonly used to treat seizures, may decrease the effectiveness of olanzapine. Further dosage adjustments, if indicated, should generally occur at intervals of not less than 1 week, since steady state for olanzapine would not be achieved for The physician who elects to use Zyprexa for extended periods should periodically reevaluate the long-term usefulness of the drug for the individual patient.
