Apply the patch to the skin behind your ear. Replace it with a fresh patch every three days. While young children shouldn't take scopolamine, a prescription for kids over the age of 12 is possible. Talk to your doctor if The medication comes in a patch form and is applied to the skin behind the ear. Scopolamine Dimenhydrinate (Dramamine) is another antihistamine used to treat motion sickness and nausea.
