How does this medication work? The herpes virus can still be spread even when you do not have blisters or sores. To reduce the risk of spreading the virus, wash your hands immediately after touching your skin sores. People who have a weakened immune system should only use valacyclovir if the benefits outweigh the risks. It should be used in combination with safer sex practices such as using condoms and dental dams. Treatment should be started within 72 hours of the onset of symptoms, and ideally within 48 hours for best effectiveness. Put Some Spring in Your Step. Since caffeine, alcohol, the nicotine from cigarettes, or street drugs can affect the action of many medications, you should let your prescriber know if you use them. If you experience signs of decreased kidney function, such as decreased urine production, nausea, fatigue, or muscle twitches or cramps, contact your doctor as soon as possible. Ask your pharmacist how to dispose of medications that are no longer needed or have expired. It does not cure shingles, cold sores, or genital herpes, but it does help the sores to heal more quickly, and it relieves pain and discomfort.
