Pyridium will cause your urine to be dark or turn it to an orange or red color. This is a normal effect and is not cause for alarm. If you wear contact lens, you should discontinue. How should I take Pyridium? Take Pyridium exactly as it was prescribed for you. Do not take the medication in larger amounts, or take it for longer than recommended by your doctor. Follow the directions on your prescription label. Take this medicine with a full glass of water. To avoid stomach upset, take Pyridium with food.
