The liquid oral concentrate form of Zoloft must be diluted before you take it. Your doctor should check your progress at regular visits. It is not known whether sertraline passes into breast milk or if it could harm a nursing baby. Do not use Zoloft if you have used an MAO inhibitor in the past 14 days, such as isocarboxazid, linezolid, methylene blue injection, phenelzine, rasagiline, selegiline, or tranylcypromine. Ask your doctor before taking a sleeping pill, narcotic medication, muscle relaxer, or medicine for anxiety, depression, or seizures. Do not take extra medicine to make up the missed dose. However, you may have a relapse of depression if you stop taking your antidepressant. Sertraline affects chemicals in the brain that may be unbalanced in people with depression, panic, anxiety, or obsessive-compulsive symptoms.
