It's less work to write a prescription and pretend the problem is solved. Keep in mind that, contrary to many people's beliefs, doctors don't get a cut of drugs they prescribe, and nobody is forcing or often even asking them to prescribe them. Because almost 20 percent of all adults complain of reflux-type symptoms, doctors tend to throw the drugs around at the first mention of mild heartburn. The overuse of drugs like Nexium isn't a new problem. Once you start the drugs, it's very, very hard to stop; even the stomachs of healthy people become "addicted" to the drugs.
