This damage can lead to bleeding. With the new changes, prescriptions for tramadol may be refilled up to five times in six months after the date on the prescription. Using aspirin to prevent blood clots can also affect the natural healing of damaged blood vessels and increase the risk of bleeding in the brain. Prescriptions written prior to October 6 and those that have refills may continue to be filled as written on the original prescription or until April 8, whichever happens first. For drugs and substances approved for medical uses, Schedule II is the most restrictive category with the highest potential for abuse or dependency. Aug 13, - Tramadol prescriptions are only good to be filled at your pharmacy for 6 months after the date they are written by your doctor. Once 6 months has passed from the written date, whether you've filled your prescription and any refills or not, it is considered expired. Once it is expired, a new prescription will need.
