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Olanzapine lessens anxiety and obsessional thinking, and some anorexic patients find they feel less paralyzed due to rigid thinking and behavior on this medication. Clinicians find that on olanzapine, some people with anorexia nervosa are better able to grasp their situation and engage in treatment. Patients who are taking hormones, including oral contraceptives, may also require dose adjustment due to interaction with topiramate. Weight gain alone does often normalize mood in anorexia nervosa, but it can be hard to accomplish and frequently requires hospitalization. Government agencies are currently evaluating this question. These often pass within a week or two but they may persist and should always be discussed with the physician. Malnutrition appears to preclude their usual benefits. Topiramate, a totally different category of medication that was developed for treating epilepsy. At least one study has shown this to be a successful initial approach when used by primary care providers. Unfortunately, immediate relapse is common. Although they are widely prescribed for this purpose, research studies and the clinical experience of specialists both show that SSRIs DO NOT help low-weight patients recover.
