Get emergency medical help if you have any signs of an allergic reaction to methotrexate: Tell your doctor about all your medications and any you start or stop using during treatment with methotrexate, especially:. Follow the directions on your prescription label. Methotrexate can pass into breast milk and may harm a nursing baby. Ask your doctor or pharmacist if you have questions about your dosage or how often to take this medicine. The dose may be administered every 2 to 5 days until CSF counts return to normal followed by a dose administered once weekly for 2 weeks and monthly thereafter. At this point, one additional dose is advisable. Treatment in all stages usually consists of several courses of the drug interposed with 7 to 10 day rest periods.
