FDA has recommended in the past that patients switching between branded levothyroxine products undergo repeat thyroid-function testing, which allows for dose retitration if the therapeutic target is not being achieved with the new preparation. Because suppression is so important, experts recommend that thyroid cancer survivors on suppressive therapy remain on a consistent brand-name levothyroxine drug. After patent protection expires, generic manufacturers must seek FDA approval to produce generic versions of the brand name drug. The antithyroid drug PTU, used to treat hyperthyroidism, is only available as a generic in the U. For example, an allergy or sensitivity to inactive ingredients in one generic versus another, or in a generic versus a brand-name drug, can affect how you respond to a drug. As a result, you might notice the return of symptoms of hypothyroidism or hyperthyroidism, or changes to your thyroid blood test levels. According to the FDA, there are at least three companies making generic levothyroxine, including Lannett, Mylan, and Merck. The FDA allows for as much as a 4 percent variation in potency, to account for different manufacturing processes.
