Controlled and uncontrolled clinical trials of cetirizine conducted in the United States and Canada included more than patients aged 12 years and older, with more than receiving cetirizine at doses of 5 to 20 mg per day. The duration of treatment ranged from 1 week to 6 months, with a mean exposure of 30 days.
