"I was on 50mg of Zoloft for the last 3 years, and it has somewhat reduced my panic attacks, but my depression has gotten much worse. My doctor suggested that I increase my dosage to mg, which I did. At this dosage I felt less depressed, but was much more anxious, more angry and starting experiencing manic states. The recommended initial dosage and maximum ZOLOFT dosage in patients with MDD, OCD, PD, PTSD, and SAD are displayed in Table 1 below. Mar 15, - So this is an additional benefit of Zoloft and Celexa for panic disorder. Finally, dosing Zoloft and Celexa are relatively easy for panic disorder. Zoloft dosing starts at 25mg, increasing the dose 25mg to 50mg every 2 to 4 weeks until clinical effect- maximum dose mg daily. Celexa dosing starts at 10mg.
