Bioavailability is a measure of the proportion of a drug that enters your circulation and is able to have the desired effect. The FDA allows for as much as a 4 percent variation in potency, to account for different manufacturing processes. This means that potency can vary when you switch from a brand name to a generic version of a drug, or switch from one generic drug to another.
