

pharmacological classification of nitrofurantoin

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Because of the possibility of hemolytic anemia due to immature erythrocyte enzyme systems glutathione instability , the drug is contraindicated in pregnant patients at term weeks gestation , during labor and delivery, or when the onset of labor is imminent. The resulting increase in nitrofurantoin serum levels may increase toxicity, and the decreased urinary levels could lessen its efficacy as a urinary tract antibacterial. The drug also can disrupt bacterial cell wall formation. Apo-Nitrofurantoin, a nitrofuran antibacterial agent, is available in microcrystalline and macrocrystalline form to treat urinary tract infections caused by many gram-negative and some gram-positive bacteria.
